

SPECIAL TEMPORARY ENROLMENT SCHEME: Springston School

This scheme commences on 29 May 2013.

Home zone

All students who live within the home zone **described below** (and *shown on the attached map*) shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

The Springston Primary School Zone is defined as follows:

The area within the below boundary, including both sides of boundary roads,

- South along (Zone on the Eastern side) Days Rd from the Ellesmere Junction Rd to Collins Rd.
- East along Collins Rd then south on Springs Rd to McDonald Rd,
- East on McDonald Rd (to end of McDonald Road) then South on Englishs Rd to Carters Road,
- West on Carters Rd then south west on Wolfes Rd to Lake Ellesmere.
- West along the shore of Lake Ellesmere to the Selwyn River outlet.
- North up the Selwyn River to Days Rd. North on Days Road to Pannetts Rd
- West along Pannetts Rd to the Coes Ford (near the intersection of Pannetts Rd and Goulds Rd).
- From Coes Ford following the southern boundary of the Selwyn River to the Corbetts Rd and Brookside/Burnham Rd Ford.
- From Corbetts Rd and Brookside/Burnham Rd Ford to follow Corbetts Rd north onto Brookside Road to Ellesmere Junction Rd.
- East along Ellesmere Junction Rd to the Selwyn Rd intersection.
- North East along Selwyn Rd (Zone on the Northwestern side) to the Weedons Rd.
- South East along Weedons Rd (Zone on the Northeastern side) to the Ellesmere Junction Rd.
- West along Ellesmere Junction Rd (Zone on the South side) to Days Rd.


Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Former Greenpark School students

Students enrolled at Greenpark School on the date the Minister announced the closure of Greenpark School may be enrolled at Springston School, regardless of whether they live within the enrolment scheme home zone described above. Enrolments made under this part of special temporary enrolment scheme must occur either during 2013 or for the start of 2014 school year. This provision will also apply to siblings (not yet at school) of eligible students.

Out of zone enrolments


Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

- **First priority** This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary.
- **Second priority** must be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
- **Third priority** must be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
- **Fourth priority** must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- **Fifth priority** must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
- **Sixth priority** must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
